Please take a few minutes to read through this document **as there have been changes for 2020** and familiarise yourself with the details.

IMPORTANT

Your ticket has two perforated sections. The L section **should be signed** in front of the Marshals at the booking-in desk at Crystal Palace. The Marshal will remove the L section and issue you with a Run Pack (one Run Pack per applicant). The B section of the ticket should be removed by Marshals on entry to Madeira Drive, Brighton. The event is strictly **no ticket no entry**, so ensure you keep your ticket safe as it cannot be replaced. If your ticket is damaged please contact London & Surrey Mini Owners Club (LSMOC) **immediately**.

WARNING

Please do not remove either section of the ticket or it will be void

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1. RULES OF THE RUN

- The LSMOC reserves the right to refuse entry or disqualify any entrants from the Run without a refund. This applies to anyone who is thought to be driving recklessly, is using intimidating and abusive behaviour, or does not obey the instructions of the Organisers and Marshals.
- Run tickets are non-transferable and not for re-sale. Any ticket found to be sold on auction websites will be withdrawn. This is to ensure that all Mini Owners can enjoy the Run at a reasonable price. LSMOC may allow tickets to be transferred but only with prior consent and at original cover price, please email if you require clarification.
- The Club does not accept liability for any loss or damage of any kind due to participating in the Run. Remember thieves may be operating on the Run or in the area so lock all valuables away.
- All entrants are required to park in the official parking areas at Crystal Palace Park and Brighton. Use of the public car parks and side streets at Crystal Palace for official entrants is not permitted.
- The Run is for all Minis (whatever shape or form but excluding the Mini Metro). If you turn up with any other car, you will not be permitted entry to Crystal Palace or Madeira Drive. Trailers and vehicles towing Minis will **not** be allowed into show areas.

- Due to local Bylaws at both Crystal Palace Park and Madeira Drive, Brighton; and for health & safety reasons, drones must not be used at any point over the L2B weekend. Anyone caught using them will be ejected from the Run and will be banned from future L2B's.
- The Show 'n' Shine Judge's decision is final. The rights to transfer any Mini from class to class in the Show 'n' Shine are reserved. If you have any dispute, please write to the Chairman (address on page 4).
- Follow the Marshals' instructions AT ALL TIMES.
- No charging or discharging of fuel tanks is permitted at any of the show areas. Any spillages must be reported to a Marshal immediately.
- The ULEZ charge zone in London came into effect from 8th April 2019. It covers the current congestion charge area and most cars will be liable to a £12.50 charge if you enter the zone. For clarification no parts of the L2B run is within the zone. More details at www.tfl.gov.uk/ULEZ. The LSMOC are not liable for any charges incurred.
- There is a 5mph speed limit in Crystal Palace Park, London and on Madeira Drive, Brighton.
- Once again LSMOC will be producing a limited-edition model to commemorate the Run. To try and make the allocation fairer we will only sell these models to entrants of the L2B. If you would like to purchase a model you will need to attend the LSMOC merchandise stand in Brighton and present your Run ticket. Your ticket will be marked to show you have purchased a model. Further information will be available in the Run Programme.

2. WHAT, WHERE AND WHEN

- If you are camping and plan to arrive at Crystal Palace on Saturday 16th May 2020 - see sections 3 and 4.
- If you have entered the Run as part of an organised Club and are **part of a Club Stand, you should drive directly to Madeira Drive, Brighton and not go to Crystal Palace.** Your pack awaits you there.
- All other entrants should aim to arrive at Crystal Palace from 05.00 am onwards on Sunday 17th May 2020 and have your ticket ready to show to the marshals at the gate.
- If you have entered the Show 'n' Shine, please ensure your class sticker is displayed prominently on your windscreen **BEFORE** you arrive at the park, you should also have removed any SNS stickers from previous years.

3. DIRECTIONS TO CRYSTAL PALACE

- From the East, leave the M25 at junction 4 then follow the A21 and travel west, then follow the A214.
- From the South, leave the M25 at junction 7 then follow the M23 / A23 towards London and then the A235 from Purley to Croydon. Then the A212 around the one-way system and turn right on to the A214. Alternatively leave the M25 at junction six and follow the A22 to Purley and turn right on to the A235 and then the A212.
- From Central London follow the A23 to Streatham Common and then turn left on to the A214.
- If you wish to use a map, website or Sat Nav system the address of the park is *Crystal Palace Park, Anerley Hill, London, SE19 2BB*. **Please note that the post code is only an approximate location.**



Note:

Entry to the park is from the downhill direction of the A214, if you are coming up the hill you must continue up to the traffic lights, turn left to next lights, turn right and finally right again. **KEEP OUT OF ANY BUS LANES IN THE AREA.**

4. CAMPING DETAILS

- All rules of the Run apply to the camping area.
- Gates open for camping at Crystal Palace Park at 12.00 Saturday 16th May 2020. If you arrive before this time you will be directed to park in a public parking area until the gates open.
- Camping is free and there is no need to pre-book and you may park your vehicle next to your tent. Due to the earlier opening time for camping and the risk of increased numbers, LSMOC may change the layout for camping arrangements and mark out specific areas, you should follow the directions of the Marshals and be aware that we cannot ensure a camping place that is with people who are not with you at time of arrival.
- **Open fires, Chinese lanterns, fireworks or exhaust flammers are NOT allowed at any time**, however small disposable BBQs are allowed if raised off the ground. Dustbin bags will be provided to all vehicles on entry and we ask that all rubbish be collected. Please do not place hot ash in bin bags but leave separate for collection.
- If you leave the park in your car please note the gates close at Midnight and you will NOT be allowed back in after this time, except on foot.
- Do not camp in areas which are cordoned off, as this may delay the start of the Run.
- Noise should be kept to a minimum, especially after 11.00 pm.
- There is a professional camp site very close by run by the Caravan Club and this is open to the general public. This is ideal for those who would need to stay longer, prefer better facilities or for those with families or who prefer a quieter night, please call 0208 778 7155 or visit <http://www.caravanclub.co.uk/> (Note LSMOC are not responsible for this camp site or arrangements).
- Finding Alan after 11:00 pm is officially pointless as he has been missing for years!

5. ARRIVAL ON SUNDAY MORNING AT CRYSTAL PALACE

- Aim to arrive from 5.00 am onwards on Sunday 17th May 2020. Your Run number is for LSMOC use only and does not apply to your place in the queue!
- Please present your ticket to the Marshals on the entrance gate. **You must have a valid ticket, you will not be allowed entry on the Run without one! REPLACEMENT TICKETS WILL NOT BE ISSUED.**
- If you do not have a ticket ready for inspection upon arrival you will be directed to another parking area and will be able to enter once you have your ticket.
- If you have a place in the Show 'n' Shine event, please ensure you display your sticker clearly on your windscreen **before you enter**; remember to remove last year's sticker. Show 'n' Shine entrants are required to park in a different area and displaying your sticker will ensure we know to do this. **Your sticker will have been posted to you prior to the Run.**
- Proceed **SLOWLY at 5 mph** and follow the Marshals instructions regarding where to park.
- Once parked take care getting out of the car as there will be moving vehicles near you. Make your way on foot with your ticket (intact and unsigned) to the booking-in desks.
- The driver will be required to sign for receipt of the Run Pack and acknowledgement of the Rules of the Run on part L of your ticket. A Marshal will remove this part of your ticket. Please remember to take your ticket away with you as you will need it to gain entry to Madeira Drive, Brighton.
- If you have entered the Show 'n' Shine you will need to register at the SNS desk as noted in your SNS pack.
- Once in possession of your Run Pack, attach the plaque to the front of your car, the sticker to the windscreen and T-shirt to your chest.
- A limited number of additional T-Shirts and car flags will be available to purchase at Crystal Palace during the morning, and all day from the LSMOC Merchandise stand in Brighton.

6. THE RUN

- Precise details of the route are provided in the event programme which is issued in the Run pack. However once released from Crystal Palace Park you should follow the Run road signs along the A23.

- Timing is very important and to ensure we are ready for all cars arrival in Brighton it is essential that all entrants park inside the area at Crystal Palace and leave at the correct time and use the official route. We have had an increasing problem with entrants not using official parking areas, and this means that you may arrive at Brighton before Madeira Drive is ready. General Run entrants will not be permitted on to Madeira Drive, Brighton before 10.00 am so please do not try to queue jump and park outside.
- The event's official photographers will be taking pictures of all cars as they leave Crystal Palace Park, and once they arrive in Brighton. Copies of these will be available to purchase at the photographer's trade stand. Only cars using the official parking areas can purchase photographs.

7. ARRIVAL AT BRIGHTON

- Once on the outskirts of Brighton the Run signs will direct you around the outside of Brighton, entering Brighton from the EAST, thus passing Dukes Mound before reaching the Pier. If you have 'SNS' (Shown 'n' Shine) or 'CS' (Club Stand) stickers you should continue to the Pier roundabout. All other entrants should enter via the Dukes Mound end of Madeira Drive.
- If you decide to enter Brighton via the A23, be prepared for slow traffic. Follow the signs for the seafront, passing the Royal Pavilion on your right.
- At the roundabout opposite Brighton Pier, only minis displaying an SNS or CS sticker will be permitted access. If you do not have one of these stickers, **DO NOT attempt access!** The Marshals on the gate will direct you to your stand/class. Please follow their directions. **Do NOT exceed 5 mph.**
- All other entrants should turn at the Pier roundabout up the hill above Madeira Drive, to turn on to Dukes Mound (or just follow the Mini in front and hope they don't have a pass). A Marshal will direct you to a parking space. Please drive slowly, following the Marshal's instructions.

8. HANDY HINTS

- Check the website www.london-to-brighton.co.uk for regular updates.
- Camping will start at 12 Midday on Saturday and a programme of free entertainment is being devised for the day - check the website for updated information as it becomes available.
- If your address or car details change, please email us at the address on the front of this booklet with your new details as soon as possible.
- Please follow the Highway Code. The Police have been notified of the Run and will be observing en-route so keep to the speed limits. Two hours have been given for the Run. It is not a race and there is no advantage to being first. There are lots of speed cameras on the A23.
- Please notify us if you are a blue disabled badge holder with special needs prior to the Run. **Disabled parking MUST be pre-arranged.**

9. WEEKEND TIMETABLE

SATURDAY 16TH MAY 2020

12.00 Midday Camping starts

- The gates open for camping - see Section 4 for camping rules.
- An entertainment programme for Saturday is being devised and will be available via our website www.london-to-brighton.co.uk

7.00 pm till 8.00pm Lining up of cars

- Marshals will be available to start lining up cars ready for the run on Sunday but the exact time we start varies from year to year.

12.00 Midnight

- The gates will close for vehicle entry. If you arrive after this time you will have to seek alternative parking, you can park in the lower car park until the gates re-open at 5am

SUNDAY 17TH MAY 2020

5.00 am Gates re-open

- The gates will open for entry into the park.

5.30 am Registration starts

- The booking-in desks will open to issue the Run Packs.

5.30 am Show 'n' Shine registration starts

- Mileage records are noted for those entered in Show 'n' Shine.

7.30 am Registration desks close

- If you haven't collected your pack yet where have you been?

8.00 am Driver's briefing

- Please attend the Driver's briefing. We may need to inform you of any changes of plan (although we hope there will be none!), any road works, speed cameras and finally to go over the route of the Run.

8.30 am The Run begins (8.00 am if in Shown 'n' Shine)

- Minis will commence departure at approximately 8.30 am. It will take a while to move all 2100 cars from the Park, so PLEASE be patient.
- REMEMBER Follow the Mini in front of you until clear of the Park, switching lanes while we are trying to get all the cars out of the park causes further delay, and any offending Minis will be re-started or disqualified.
- Follow the official Run direction signs - "London to Brighton Mini Run" - to the A23. Once on the A23, follow signs to Brighton.

10. SHOW 'N' SHINE

- The Show 'n' Shine competition is a great opportunity for you to show off your car. **It is not a concours competition and your car does not have to be perfect, however the standard is very high.** It is about how clean your car is and how well it is presented.
- Entry to the competition is simple, just review the class list below and decide which category suits your car and then complete and return the application form ensuring you complete all the boxes and include an SAE and a picture of your car (pictures will not be returned). Due to the ever-decreasing space at Brighton there is a limit of **TEN** cars to each category and entry is on a first come first served basis, we will however keep an additional 5 places for each class in reserve which may come available nearer the event.
- Upon receipt your application and photograph will be checked to ensure the category applied for is correct. Providing the class applied for is not full we will then book your place in that category and send you an entry information leaflet and special car sticker. The car sticker is your confirmation of entry and it **must** be displayed in your windscreen to ensure we know who you are before entry. If the class applied for is full we will attempt to move you into another suitable class, however this is not always possible. - Marking of the competition starts at around 1.00 pm and you must remain with your car from this time onward until marked.
- Processing a Show 'n' Shine application may take several weeks. Once each class is full a reserve list will be held. It is essential that if you book and are unable to take your place you inform us as soon as possible.

Explanation of Classes

A - Mini 1959 - 1969	All standard Minis and derivatives produced in this period
B - Mini 1970 - 1979	All standard Minis and derivatives produced in this period
C - Mini 1980 - 1989	All standard Minis and derivatives produced in this period
D - Mini 1990 - 2001	All standard Minis and derivatives produced in this period (Classics Only)
E - MINI 2001 - Present	All makes and models of standard New MINIS
F - Commercial	Classics Mokes, Pickups and Vans
G - Highly Modified	Highly modified classics (Altered bodywork or major customisation including race cars, shorties etc)
H - Mildly Modified	Mildly modified classics (Minor modifications and personalisation, usually cars with lots of bolt-on accessories)
I - Modified New MINIS	All new MINIs that have undergone a modification

(Cars with very minor changes should go into year-specific class)
